Additional ideas that have come from teachers as a result of implementing THE HERO BUILDER program:

• HERO Book	What if your school selected students to participate in an art project? Each student is assigned one of the HERO ACTION WORDS to illustrate with art. <i>For example:</i> On the page is the phrase – A HERO is 'Respectful' to others! The student draws what being respectful to others looks like to them. When all Character Traits of a HERO are drawn, they can be put in book form for your school to enjoy (like the yearbook they receive). This may be a good fund-raiser project for your students to participate in. Contact us via <i>www.TheHeroBuilder.com</i> for assistance.
• HERO Bench	When a student needs a word of encouragement, they go to the HERO bench where another student provides encouragement, help, etc.
• HERO of the Day	Teachers appoint student leaders in their class to select HERO of the day (all kids have a hero in them to be celebrated).
• HERO of the Day	Staff and Students – To be announced over the school PA.
• HERO Action Words	Announced over the PA weekly
• HERO Cape	Assistant Principal at an Elementary School made capes for all the Education Assistants and knighted them with the cape in a session. Every Friday, they have the option of wearing their capes to keep "The HERO Builder" top of mind.
• HERO Journal	The Hero Builder Journal Page to track HERO Growth
